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- Walk-in or schedule an appointment ahead of time by calling 882-7365 for lab—call 882-7240 for body composition (radiology exam) testing
- Check in at the front admissions desk in the hospital's main entrance

## What is My Health Testing?

My Health Testing allows you to choose the tests you wish to have performed at a reduced price and without a provider's order.

## Why My Health Testing?

You may choose to utilize this service if you:

- Wish to have more frequent testing than your health insurance plan will cover
- Want to assess and manage your health status on a regular basis
- Are uninsured or have a high deductible and want to take advantage of lower out-of-pocket expenses

## My Health Tests

<b>WELLNESS PANELS</b>	<b>PRICE</b>
<b>General Health Panel</b> —Includes General Chemistry, Uric Acid, Lipid Panel, CBC, and TSH	\$75
<b>INDIVIDUAL TESTS</b>	<b>PRICE</b>
<b>General Chemistry</b> – 14-test panel which measures blood sugar, electrolytes, proteins, and overall kidney and liver function as well as uric acid	\$25
<b>Lipid Panel</b> – Triglycerides (fats and fatty substances), Cholesterol, HDL (good cholesterol), LDL (bad cholesterol) <b>*Please fast for 12-14 hours prior to test</b>	\$25
<b>CBC</b> – (Complete Blood Count)— Provides information about the types and amounts of cells in the blood, including WBC (white blood cell), RBC (red blood cell), HGB (hemoglobin), HCT (hematocrit), platelet	\$20
<b>TSH</b> – (Thyroid Stimulating Hormone) Used to evaluate thyroid gland function and monitor thyroid replacement therapy	\$25
<b>Hemoglobin A1c</b> – Used to diagnose diabetes and monitor blood sugar control in diabetic patients	\$25
<b>PSA Screening</b> – Prostate cancer screening, males only	\$25
<b>Vitamin D</b> – Used to evaluate bone health	\$65
<b>Iron Profile</b> — Used to diagnose anemia and iron deficiency	\$65
<b>Blood Type</b> – ABO, Rh	\$25
<b>Covid-19 IgG AB</b> – To determine immune status to Covid-19 virus	\$80
<b>RADIOLOGY TESTS</b>	<b>PRICE</b>
<b>Body Composition</b> – Radiology exam that Identifies lean muscle mass, bone and percentage of body fat	\$40

- A provider's order is not required
- Your tests will be mailed to you ; an explanation of lab test results is available at [labtestsonline.org](http://labtestsonline.org). They will also be available on your *My Chase Health* patient portal.
- If you would like to discuss the results with your provider, an appointment is necessary.
- Results will NOT be forwarded to your provider.
- Your insurance will NOT be billed. Payment by cash, check or credit card will be required upfront before tests are performed.
- A parent or guardian must accompany anyone under the age of 19.
